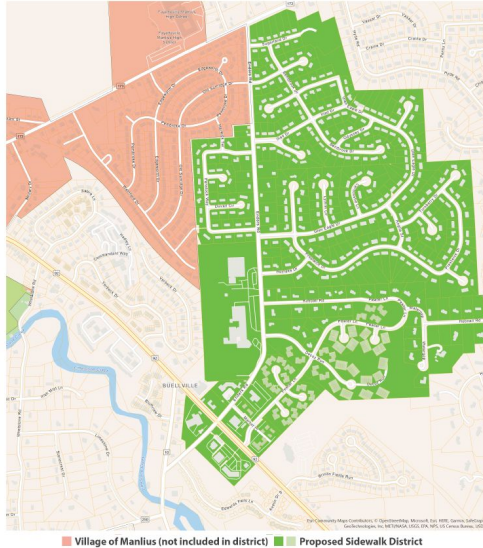

- Sent update to Town Board

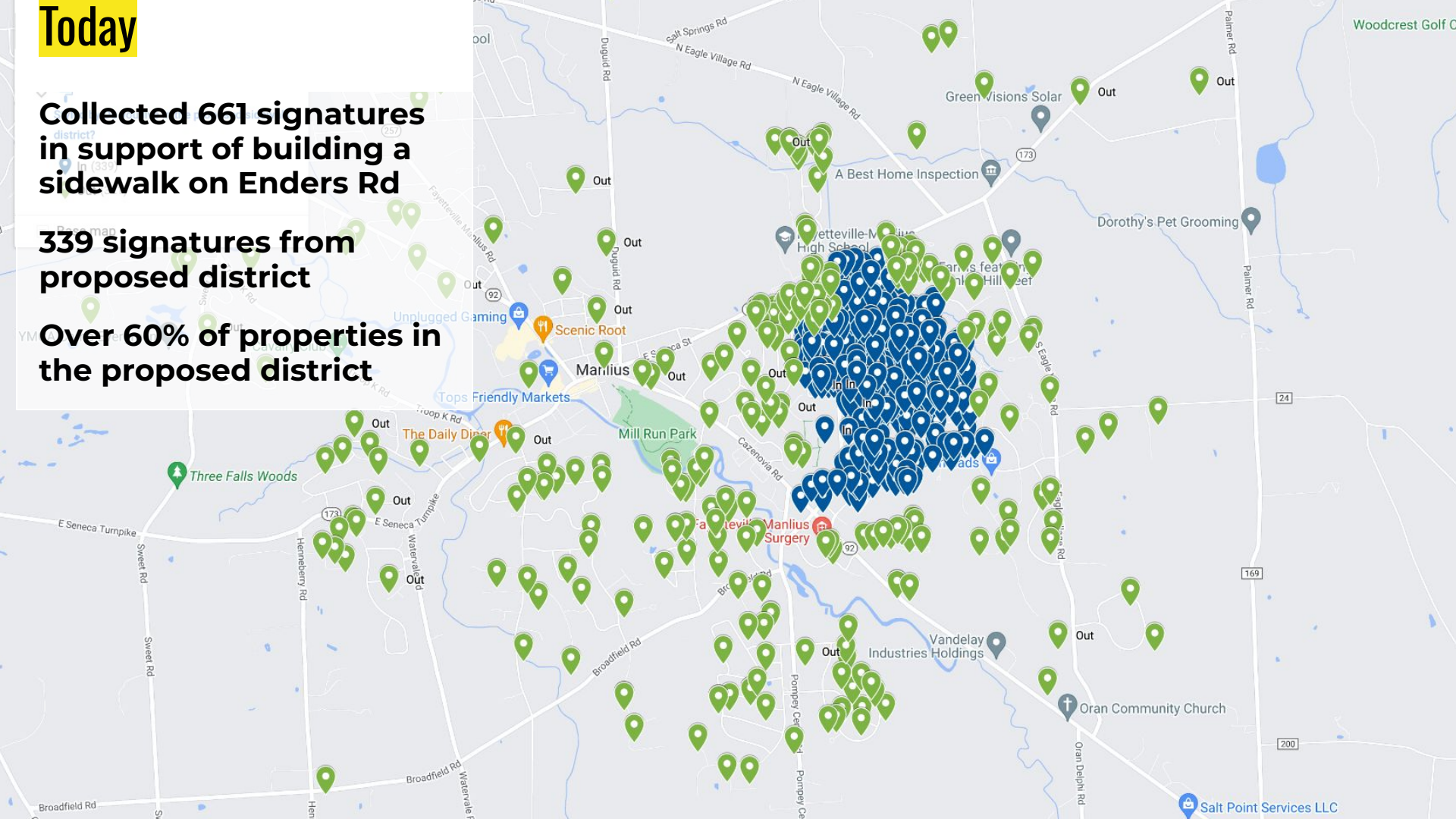

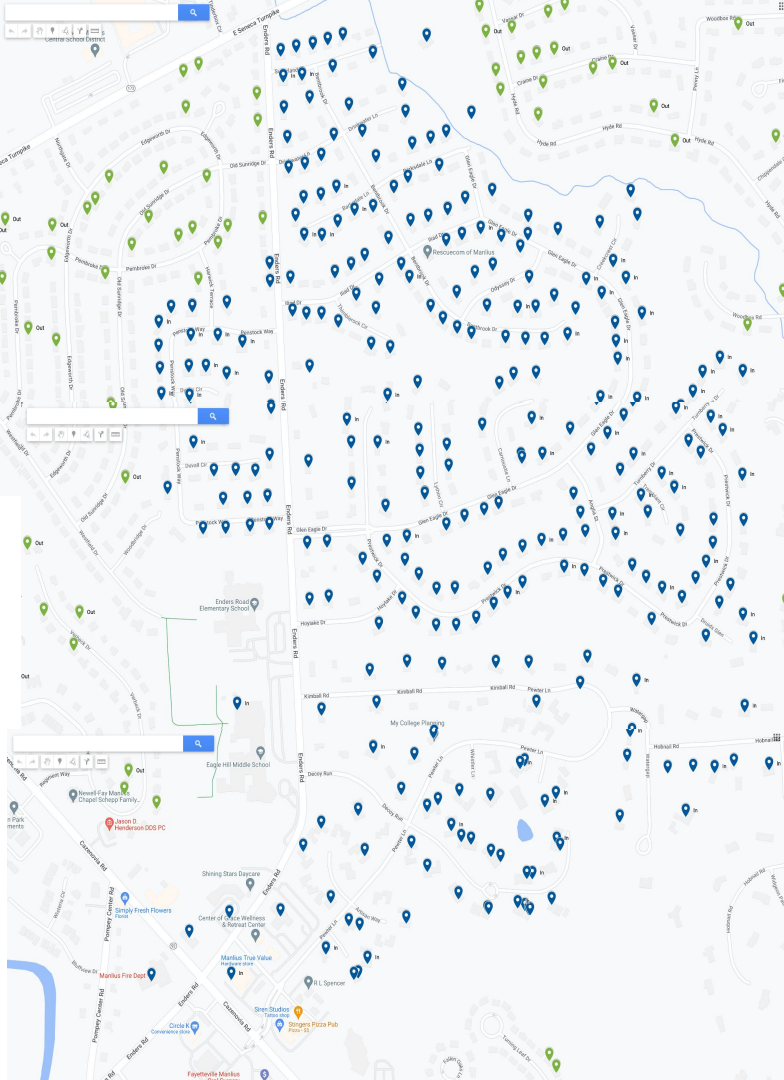

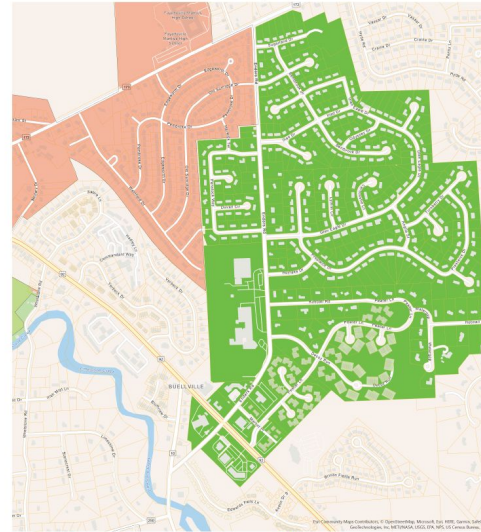

By filling out this form you are showing your support for sidewalks on Enders Road and understand the expense of the construction and maintenance of the sidewalk shall be collected from the parcels within the proposed sidewalk district.

If we collect at least 65% of property owners in the proposed sidewalk district in support of this project and the Town Board accepts this petition. The Town Board will have the town engineer draft a map, plan and report to study this project. If the reports concludes that the project qualifies for grant funding bringing costs to no more than **\$50 per year for residential properties and \$150 for commercial properties**, the Town Board will move forward with creating the Enders Road sidewalk district.

# Comments

- I think a sidewalk is so needed for the safety of our kids!!!
- I went to Enders, Eagle Hill, and FMHS for all 12 years, walking to and from school. Especially to and from FMHS, the lack of sidewalks is quite honestly dangerous, and I was close to being hit by cars walking home several times.
- I always felt it was dangerous when my kids walked to school. Also, often cars do not stop when students cross at the corner of 173 and Enders.
- Yes!!! Please for the love of god put sidewalks in! I have been asking for this for YEARS!!!! Just to be told “sorry, too bad” pretty much...I worried sick for my son when he was little about walking to school from Pewter Lane, would never let him do it because of this issue...Would love to see this happen for the safety of our little ones in the area and anyone else walking frankly

# Comments

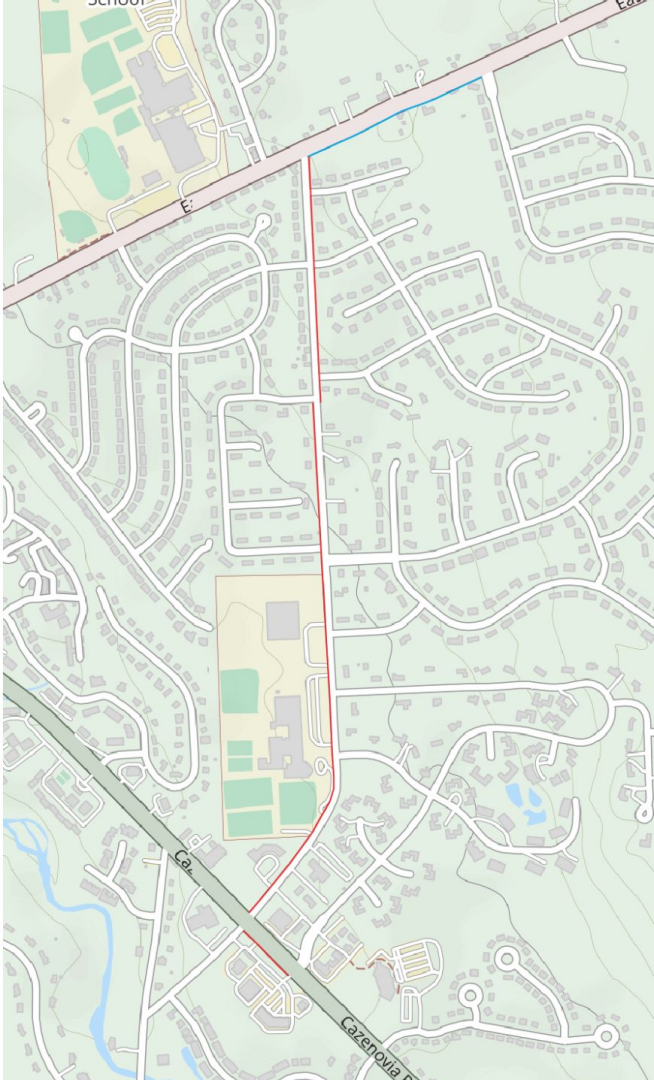
- Please put in sidewalks to keep our kids safe and promote walking!

- I fully support this. It's unsafe for our school-aged children to walk on Enders Rd which links 3 of the 6 FM District schools. We need a sidewalk for their safety and their health. More kids walking would benefit their health and fitness. Thank you for attempting this for our community.
- They should've been in 20 years ago. It's a little ridiculous we have to have a petition to get them put in.
- Enders should have sidewalks. Safety, convenience, and common sense all point to the fact that there should be a way to walk from the elementary school to the high school.

# Comments

- Due to only one shuttle being sent to Eagle Hill a day many athletes are needing to walk to the high school on the street without a sidewalk, which is very unsafe a sidewalk would help protect our children.
- I walk here after school a lot and from experience I think that this would be beneficial to the area and help encourage walking
- I teach at Enders Road. I see students walking on the road daily and have personally seen way too many close calls of someone getting very hurt or even killed. It's a school = children = SIDEWALKS. Common sense.
- I can't believe this wasn't done years ago! It's SO dangerous for the kids who walk to/from school, and anyone who walks on Enders Rd. Even more so in the winter!
- This is a very important project and I will definitely needs to be done! Enders is not a safe road to walk on!! Let's change that.

# Comments

- Sidewalks are long overdue and vital to the safety of children and all pedestrians on Enders Road.
- Our children attend Fayetteville Manlius High School and Eagle Hill Middle School. Is very dangerous for them to walk to school because there is no sidewalks. My neighbor daughter was hit by a car walking to school 2 years ago . Please Yes to sidewalks for the safety of the children.
- I am a student from eagle hill 8th grade. Me and my friend always walk to Gabriella's/ walgreen and Circle K. I'd hope that there is a side walk to provide safety for us students and if it actually happened that will be great.
- Please install a sidewalk along Enders! I see kids walking along enders in the dark, and during the day, leading to dangerous situations. Please prioritise the safety of our children and other pedestrians!

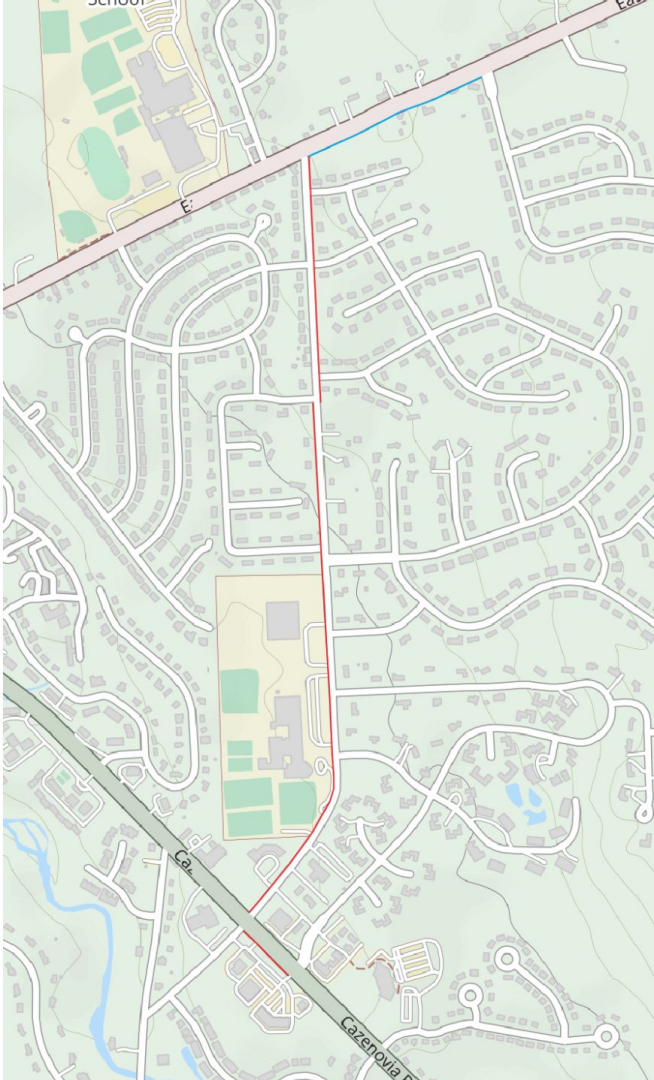


## Study Area

- Enders Road
- Small Portion of 92
- Received feedback from Eagle View residents to include small portion of 173
- Many residents around this area would benefit. Up to Town Board for final district lines

# Concerns We Heard

- **How much will it cost?**
  - We broke down the costs with a rough quote for concrete vs asphalt from MJ Engineering with an estimate of 70% in grant funding: \$50 residential & \$150 for commercial parcels.
- **How many trees will be cut down and will they be replaced?**
- **Some residents who did not sign our petition still supported sidewalks on Enders Rd but wanted it to be included in town taxes not an additional tax**
- **Will sidewalk be lighted?**
- **Crosswalks signs with flashing lights**
- **Pedestrian improvements wanted at intersections of 173 & 92**
